Trends for Montana 2017

Outdoor kitchens and BBQ islands topped the list last year as the fastest growing trend both nationally and locally in Montana with no signs of slowing down. Residents are beginning to expand their homes to include a comfortable space outside to enjoy the spectacular Montana landscape. In past decades a landscape would only include a small patio or deck with enough space to include a stand-alone grill with a patio set surrounded by a lot of grass and maybe a tree or two. This environment typically would serve an occasional birthday party and minimal time spent outdoor. Residents would spend the majority of their time mowing their grass and maintaining their property rather than living in it.

Today there is a shift to balance the backyard, to reduce maintenance and spend more time enjoying the space available. After a short meeting it was clear the entryway was weak and easily missed, a viewing area where guests could sit and take in the scenery, and outdoor lighting was planned so the outdoor space planned could be used into the evening hours was needed. After completion enormous boulders frame the driveway resembling a large outcropping. A custom

viewing bench fabricated completely "in-house" was placed in a grove of trees made entirely of the natural elements that surround them. Custom light fixtures set in historic cedar stumps give the area a completely natural look. Even a plain large retaining wall was given new color with native sedum plants tucked into the cracks.
